## ASK THE EXPERTS

Perfumers Jean-Marc Chaillan and Laurent Le Guerneq tell the scent story



**Q** Do you have any tips for choosing a fragrance for someone?

**A** Jean-Marc: Fragrance is personal. While someone who's sophisticated might like anything from woody to floral, or a sensual type could prefer a sweet scent, it's much easier to put the scent you associate him or her with into one of the olfactory families — citrus, floral, Oriental, woody, chypre (oak moss and patchouli) and fougere (contains oak moss and musk) for men. Then pick another scent in the same family. Fragrance has different stages of development, so if you're shopping for yourself, I recommend spritzing the sample and living with it for a couple of hours or even overnight.

**Q** What were your favorite fragrances to work on?

**A** Jean-Marc: Creating a fragrance is like watching a love story unfold. I enjoyed working on Hugo Boss Baldessarini. Laurent: Collaborating with Sarah Jessica Parker and L'Oréal was
