## SEXY UPDO

For **Christina Milian's** sexy half-updo, start by drying hair smooth. Then use a medium-barrel curling iron to create volume and waves. Grab small sections of hair at each temple and loosely twist back toward the base of the crown. Secure with bobby pins.

## SLEEK STRANDS

Turn up the glamour with sleek, ultrashiny strands like **Gwyneth Paltrow's**. Start by drying hair smooth with a flat boar-bristle brush. Spritz dry hair with a heat-protecting spray and flat-iron hair straight. For extra shine, apply a pea-sized amount of gloss to the ends.

## FLIRTY WAVES

For a more casual look, try playful waves as **Jessica Biel** has. Apply a curl-enhancing cream to damp hair and blow-dry using a diffuser attachment. Or use a large-barrel curling iron to add and define waves. Use fingers, not a brush, to style.
